Place all your organic waste in the brown bin, in side the compostable

Place the paper inside the blue bin, do not use any plastic bag. .

Only if needed use paper bags or boxes.

Place glass and metal, without bag, inside the green bin with microchip. TARI users that haven't already received the new bins have to go to the Ecocentro with their ID or with the authorization approval form.

HOW TO RECYCLE BULKY WASTE?

Call the free number and place the waste next to your door in the scheduled day indicated by the phone operator. Without obstructin the street.

WHY DIDN'T MY RECYCLING BIN GET EMPTIED?

There are several reasons for your missed waste collection:

- 1. Non-compliant waste inside the bag;
- 2.Bin not being placed on the property's boundary on collection day;
- 3.Bin not being placed on the right time.

HOW TO LEAVE YOUR RUBBISH OUT

Leave out the rubbish before 6am or the night before according to the scheduled days of the collection calendar. Non-compliant bins or those not being placed on the correct day will not be collected and a notice will be applied to them.

ORGANIC WASTE YES • PLACE IT IN THE BROWN BIN WITH MICROCHIP. INSIDE THE BIODEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE **BAG**

Fruit, vegetables, eggs, fish and its residues, crustaceans, mussel shells, clams etc., meat and small bones, bread, pasta, rice, leftovers, kitchen scraps and spoiled food, coffee grounds, tea and chamomile bags and , used napkins and paper tissues, pets waste and bedding (if biodegradable, clay, sawdust, shavings, natural sand or paper).

Small quantities of floral and paint waste, lifeless fireplace ashes.

ORGANIC WASTE NO

Nappies, pads, toilet papers, mops, pizza boxes, food packaging (from butcher, fish shop, deli etc.), animal waste (rabbits, chickens, etc.). Synthetic pets bedding.

NON-RECYCLABLE YES • PLACE IT IN THE GREY BAG WITH RFID TAG

Food packaging (from butcher, fish shop, deli etc.), Rubber, cassette players, videotapes, cd s and dvds, plastic cutlery, pens, small plastic and bakelite objects, hair and personal hygiene accessories (toothbrushes, hair brushes and combs, hair clips and pins, etc.), carbon paper, laminated paper, nylon socks, jute bags, unusable mops, medical gauzes, plasters and syringes, nappies, pads, used toilet paper, cosmetics, feathers, synthetic pets bedding. Ceramic dishes, cups and mugs pieces, broken mirrors. Home and hoover dust, varnished wood small objects, light bulbs, small plastic objects, cigarette butts, chewing gum, objects made of different material impossible to separate.

NON-RECYCLABE NO

All materials that can be recycled!

Used tissues and napkins, pizza boxes, plastic dishes and glasses, tetrapak (milk and juice boxes), rice, brioche and pasta boxes, paper leaflets, toothpaste, pharmaceutical and cosmetic packaging, crisps and frozen food packaging, cellophane and styrofoam packaging, styrofoam bowls, plastic fruit cases, aluminium baking tray and foil, hair spray, shaving cream and deodorants aluminium containers. Garments and textiles, Plaster flakes, concrete bags, toxic bins, waste containers of glue, solvents, paints, resins, etc., agricultural and industrial waste, agricultural containers with pesticides, fertilizers and composts, pvc pipes for water supply, tyres, inner tubes, batteries and car filters, motor oil and any kind of lubricants, car and motorcycle pieces, windows and doors bathroom fixtures, bath tubs, radiators, hydraulic tubes, taps, parts of electrical systems, furnaces,

PLASTIC YES. PLACE IT EXCLUSIVELY IN THE SPECIFIC YELLOW

Plastic water bottles, fruit juice, milk, yoghurt containers, cheese cream and dessert, food for animals, detergent and sanitary containers. Bags and food containers, cellophane for brioches, crisps, frozen food, pasta, rice, meat and fish. Eggs bowls, styrofoam bowls and packaging. Fruit and vegetable packaging nets. Fruit and vegetable cases (1 piece for every collection day). Clean jugs and bins, plastic dishes and glasses. Hangers and small

Toys, tapes, cds and videotapes, plastic cutlery, food containers, hair and sanitary accessories (like toothbrush, brushes and combs, hair clips and pins) bins, pieces and car accessories, pvc pipes for water supply, waste containers of glue, solvents, paints, resins, etc., any element in Plexiglas and polythene, packaging made of different material impossible to

PAPER/CARDBOARD YES • PLACE IT EXCLUSIVELY INSIDE THE **BLUE WASTE BIN WITH MICROCHIP**

Newspapers, magazines, leaflets, paper boxes, food boxes (ex. rice, pasta, sugar, etc.), pizza boxes, sheet of paper, books and notebooks, tetrapak containers of milk, juice, tomato passata. Plastic bags use is absolutely banned for paper delivery.

PAPER/CARDBOARD NO

Nylon, cellophane, wax paper, used toilet paper, pads, carbon paper, scroll, dirty paper, used napkins, laminated paper and cardboards, concrete's bags. Objects made of different materials impossible to separate except for tetrapak.

GLASS-CANS YES • PLACE IT EXCLUSIVELY INSIDE THE WASTE **GREEN BIN WITH MICROCHIP AND WITHOUT BAG**

Bottles, demijohns, vases, glasses and jars.

Cans, food bowls, tin foil (like aluminium foil for yoghurt), food boxes (tuna, meat, fish, vegetables, peeled tomatoes), sweets bowl, aluminium baking trays, small tubes(conden-

sed tomato, mayonnaise, anchovy paste), little tubes for make-up, aluminium caps and seals, cream spray cans, deodorant, hair spray, shaving cream.

GLASS-CANS NO

Pottery and porcelain objects, light bulbs, neon, mirror, reticulate and opal glass and cans (ex. perfume bottles), computer and tv screens, pirex (ex. Oven pans), door and window glasses. Iron, spray cans. Bags use is absolutely banned for glass and aluminium cans

BULKY WASTE YES • DISPOSE MAX 5 PIECES EACH TIME

Washing machines, dishwasher, fridge, television, computer, printer, video recorder, electric oven, hi-fi, bed frames and e mattress, armchairs and sofas, old furniture, small appliances (telephone, mobile phones, blenders, toaster, coffee machine, toys), pallets, wood objects.

BULKY WASTE NO

Pieces of plaster, concrete sacks, toxic bins, buckets with any kind of waste (ex. glues, solvents, varnish, resin, etc.), industrial and agricultural waste, agricultural containers with pesticides, fertilizers and composts, pvc pipes for water supply, tyres, inner tubes, batteries and car filters, motor oil and any kind of lubricants, car and motorcycle pieces, windows and doors, paper and cardboards, sanitary, bathroom fixtures, bath tubes, radiators, hydraulic tubes, taps, parts of electrical systems, furnaces, gates, railings, toner.

PLANT CLIPPINGS AND PRUNING

Grass and garden cuttings, untreated wood and sawdust,, leaves and flowers, grass, roots and straw, cutted trunks, have to be delivered to the Ecocentro Comunale without soil. stones, vases or flowerpot dishes. All dead branches have to be organised in twine and raff faggots, according to the following guidelines: dead branches length, half meter, weight about 20 kilograms. It is allowed a maximum of 5 large packages disposal per pick up.

Non-compliant or bigger packages won't be accepted. **VEGETABLE AND MINERAL OIL WASTE**

VEGETABLE OIL

Booking collection for disadvantaged consumers (disabled, elderly); delivery to the

Vegetable oil waste ("exhausted oil"). The used edible oil is a residue that comes from frying, cooking and preserving vegetable seed oils . Once used, it becomes a waste and it is important to recycle it. If used oil is thrown onto the ground, down the drain or the sink it can reach aguifers and contaminate water. If, instead, it reaches the drainage system, it affects the functionality and requires an extraordinary maintenance with rising costs for the domestic user. Do not pour used oil down the sink. Recycle exhausted oil and allow its high recovery potential, from waste to resource. Re-refined oil, in fact, can be used to generate electricity and/or for machinery lubrication.

This service is only for domestic users. Place the exhausted oil in the specific container at home. Once full it can only be delivered to the Ecocentre

MINERAL OIL

Mineral oil, (for cars), can exclusively be delivered to the Ecocentre from domestic users. **INERT WASTE**

In order to benefit from this service, TARI household have to strictly conform to the following rules: for inert waste delivery - cer 170107 - to the Ecocentro comunale, maximum quantity is 0.2 mc/per week (about 4 buckets) for a maximum of 1 mc/per year. In order to avoid non-compliant waste refusal it is important to know that :

•Inert waste is (cer170107 concrete mixture, bricks, tiles and pottery) only small interventions of ordinary maintenance: ex.: domestic and non-hazardous pieces of plaster, tiles,

•It is forbidden to insert plastic, paper, cardboard, iron, cables, paint, cellulose, silicone etc. Eternit, mineral wool and tarry insulation waste is not allowed. Waste disposal is only possible to the Ecocentro on fixed time and date (No scheduled trash pick-up).

CAR BATTERIES

Dispose to the Ecocentro comunale.

USED CLOTHING YES

Containers of used clothes include: man, woman, children's clothing, man, woman, children's underwear, paired up shoes and slippers, blankets, curtains, bed sheets, towels, towelling robes, bags, tablecloths, napkins, gloves, hats, fur coats, leather jackets, belts, wallets, work and sports uniforms.

USED CLOTHING NO

Non textile materials, single old shoes, old blankets for animals, garments with toxic chemicals, rags, mattresses.
